Sir,

As Central Government by notification, constituted a Commission, to be known as the National Commission for Homoeopathy, to exercise the powers conferred upon, and to perform the functions assigned to it, under NCH Act 2020. As per section 59 (2) of NCH Act, 2020, following has been stated:

“Notwithstanding the repeal of the Homoeopathy Central Council Act 1973, the educational and medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and the rules and regulations made thereunder shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made thereunder: Provided that anything done or any action taken as regards the educational and medical standards and requirements under the enactment under repeal and the rules and regulations made thereunder shall be deemed to have been done or taken under the corresponding provision of this Act and shall continue in force accordingly unless and until superseded by anything or by any action taken under this Act”.

As per provision in the Act, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy has been constituted with the mandate to grant permission to the existing and new medical institution of Homoeopathy. Accordingly, it is to inform you that all the relevant documents submitted by your college in Part-1 proforma were examined by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board.

2. On careful consideration of the report, the Medical Assessment and Rating Board has arrived at the following conclusion :

That the applicant has set up a Homoeopathic Medical College with the component of staff, infrastructure, equipment and instruments and other facilities where as the College has to take certain time bound steps to implement Minimum Standard Requirements of the Homoeopathy College and attached Hospital as prescribed by the National Commission for Homoeopathy for conducting BHMS course in Homoeopathy. The deficiencies observed are as under:

1 Teaching Faculty

- Total number of Full time Faculties available in UG is 23 (3 Professors, 06 Readers, and 14 lecturers) against the requirement of 24.
- Guest faculties not available against the requirement of 08.

2 Hospital Staff

- Surgeon (General Surgery), Obstetrician / Gynecologist, Pathologist/ Biochemist, Dispenser and Ward Boys/Ayas are available as part time against the requirement of fulltime.

ii. Medical Officer 01 is available against required 02.

3 Hospital Equipment:

- i. Iron beds (Simple, Surgical & Paediatrics) 46 available against 50.
- ii. Artery forceps, small and big 10 each available against 12.

4 Discrepancies in engagement of Teachers

- i. **Anatomy, Physiology, Organon, Pharmacy, Materia Medica, Pathology, FMT, POM, Surgery, OBG, CM, Repertory:** No documents for Teaching/ Guest Faculty provided

5 Part Time Teachers

- i. Not available against the requirement of 09. No documents for Consultant of Modern Medicine provided.


3. After considering the provisions of section 12C (1) of Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and HCC(MSR) Regulations, 2013, permission of the Medical Assessment and Rating Board is issued to **Calcutta Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital, 265-266, Acharya Prafulla Chandra Road, Kolkata, West Bengal 700009 for continuing admissions in 1-BHMS course during the academic year 2021-22 with intake capacity of 63 seats in UG (BHMS) course and 07 seats in the PG Dept. of Practice of Medicine, including EWS seats subject to availability of Guides as per Homoeopathy (Post Graduate Degree course) M.D. (Hom.) Regulations, 1989 as amended upto 2016 in the concerned subjects, for the academic session year 2021-22. The College Principal is directed to fulfill the deficiencies within three months and an affidavit in this regard may be submitted to the Medical Assessment Board within a period of one week.**

4. All admissions in Under Graduate and Post graduate course shall be through NEET/AIAPGET only. It is further informed that, minimum 15% of seats of the permitted intake capacity of BHMS course shall be treated as All India quota. The counseling for seats under All India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling Authority of State / UT Government as designated by the Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counseling Authority of that State / UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government for All India quota or the student admitted thereunder.

5. The category wise list of selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET/AIAPGET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board as per rules.

6. The college has to comply with the full requirements of HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013 for conducting the course. All deficiencies observed and mentioned above which affects the performance of the academic Institution, through which College fails to fulfill the statutory requirements, has to be rectified within three months, from the date of issue of this permission letter and the compliance report shall be submitted by the college to Medical Assessment and Rating Board accordingly. Subsequently, the Board shall verify the compliance well in time and may conduct Online/Physical inspection for verification of compliance as per the HCC (MSR) Regulation, 2013 and will consider admissions for the academic year 2022-23.

2. After considering the provisions of section 12C (1) of Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and HCC(MSR) Regulations, 2013, recommendations of the Board of Governors to CCH, **conditional permission of the Central Government is hereby granted to Calcutta Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital, 265-266, Acharya Prafulla Chandra Road, Kolkata, West Bengal 700009 for continuing admissions in 1- BHMS course during the academic year 2020-21 with intake capacity of 63 seats in UG (BHMS) course and 08 seats in the PG Dept. of Practice of Medicine, including EWS seats.**

If any seats are not filled up in the Central Counseling, the same shall be transferred to the concerned State Government to admit students as per their rules/ reservation policies/norms. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to cooperate with the Central counseling for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**







2. The said applications were forwarded to CCH on 25.05.2017 for inspecting the college to assess the available facilities of teaching and practical training in the college as per the required norms and conditions prescribed under section 12A of the HCC Act, 1973 and the notified regulations made thereunder and to furnish the recommendations. A copy of the compliance report shall be submitted by the college to CCH under intimation to this Ministry. 



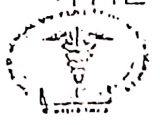
